

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:



Conducts the intake process in concert with the guidelines of CSBG and entry into electronic database.

Maintains customers' case records within the agency's centralized database system(s) detailing all activities regarding progress of goals and services received.

Provides referrals and linkages as needed for case management services (housing, nutrition, transportation, and other supportive services).

HIRING: REENTRY SPECIALIST

Reentry Specialist of the Department of Career Services provides assistance to individuals with criminal backgrounds as they complete the pardon process. Represent PCSI in the State Pardon Consortium, present at meetings and symposiums, advocate for individuals with backgrounds. Assist in Conducting PCSI Pardon Hub: Expungement clinics, Advocate to employers, instruct how to interview, and how to apply for a Pardon. the Pardon Fellow is also responsible for case management services and job development which is essential to every customer's self-sufficiency.

ReEntry



Provides case management coaching and support to individuals with a criminal background to complete the pardon process. Including obtaining records, populating application, and filing pardon.

Career Services



Conduct hiring events, job fairs, recruitment events, and network with employment agencies to assist with employment for persons with a criminal record. Refer appropriate participants to hiring events.

Confirm employment status of caseload quarterly. Upload supporting Employment Verification Form (EVF) or paystubs into database. And provide participant option of completing "PCSI Success Story"
